Gov. Jim Doyle recognizes Eppstein Uhen Architects with an Excellence in Architectural Design Award for its work on the Reuter Residence Hall at University of Wisconsin-LaCrosse. The building has 95 suite-style living units, accommodating 380 students. It was designed to complement the surrounding historical campus buildings. Project bids came in below budget, and the project was finished on schedule. The 16th annual awards highlight exemplary work on state building projects that are helping to invest in the state's infrastructure and grow the economy.
