## EUA PROJECTS WIN BIG AT THE BUSINESS JOURNAL REAL ESTATE AWARDS

MILWAUKEE — Three highly successful projects designed by Eppstein Uhen Architects were honored at *The Business Journal's* Real Estate Awards ceremony held Apr. 10, 2008 at the Hyatt Regency Milwaukee. The award-winning projects include:

- **Milwaukee Intermodal Station – Project of the Year**  
EUA worked with the City of Milwaukee and WISDOT to transform and expand the outdated Amtrak station into a landmark building that houses Amtrak's rail connection, Greyhound bus service and a potential future connection of the Metra commuter service from Chicago. Boasting a crisp and modern new design and enhanced links to amenities and attractions, the Intermodal Station will provide the public with a clear vision of 21<sup>st</sup> Century Milwaukee.
- **Manpower World Headquarters – Best New Development (Office)**  
Manpower moved its corporate headquarters from Glendale to an impressive new 280,000-square-foot campus in downtown Milwaukee. EUA designed Manpower's new headquarters to include a modern, 4-story brick and glass office facility, an adjacent 1,260-car parking structure, as well as a riverwalk promenade that maximizes the headquarters' waterfront location. The facility is widely viewed as a catalytic project that will stimulate additional development in the Park East Corridor.
- **UWM RiverView Residence Hall – Best Public/Private Partnership**  
EUA teamed with the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee to design new campus housing for the school's growing student body. Located along the Milwaukee River, the RiverView Residence Hall features 117, four-person suites and additional units for housing staff. The facility is UWM's first "Living Learning Community," where students can take classes and meet with faculty within the residence hall.
