## MILWAUKEE INTERMODAL STATION WINS DOWNTOWN ACHIEVEMENT CPR AWARD

MILWAUKEE — Milwaukee Downtown, Business Improvement District #21 has named the Milwaukee Intermodal Station as the recipient of the prestigious 2007 Downtown Achievement CPR Award. The award is given for the redevelopment of a downtown building that has maintained or increased jobs as well as enhanced the overall neighborhood.

Eppstein Uhen Architects worked with Milwaukee Intermodal Partners, LLC, WISDOT and the City of Milwaukee to transform and expand the outdated Amtrak station into a landmark building that houses WISDOT's Traffic Operations Center (TOC), Amtrak's rail connection, Greyhound bus service and a potential future connection of the Metra commuter service from Chicago.

This multi-modal transit facility now serves as the "new front door" to the City of Milwaukee, welcoming visitors to Wisconsin's major urban center. This visitor gateway, positioned adjacent to the 6th Street Viaduct and across the Menomonee River from the new Harley-Davidson Museum, is symbolic of the architectural renaissance taking place throughout the City. Boasting a crisp and modern new look and enhanced links to amenities and attractions, the Milwaukee Intermodal Station provides the public with a clear vision of 21<sup>st</sup> Century Milwaukee.
